CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTRES

PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES AT CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTRES:

- Students of ECCE (Early childhood care & education) trainees of Concerns Community college conducted story telling session for Childcare children using different teaching aids like puppets, charts, flash cards etc. Children enjoyed the story telling session.

- In the month of March 2022, a set of new toys was purchased for all the 4 Child Development Centers.

To build pre-school children's fine and gross motor skills, Building blocks, hoola hoops, stacking toys, teaching learning materials were bought.

- Concerns Community college conducted theme based activities in Childcare centers. Different types of teaching learning materials were used by the students during the sessions.

- Two of our staff conducted a workshop for pre-school teachers and trainees in KSCCW (Karnataka State Council for Child Welfare) During the workshop- developmental activities, importance of early childhood years, rhymes in various languages, games for preschool children and storytelling were taught.

- Children in the centers are involved in various activities, free play, games and fine motor activities. At concerns childcare centers, teachers focus on over all development of the children.

COMMUNITY HEALTH AND DEVELOPMENT

PROGRAM AND ACTIVITIES BY THE COMMUNITY HEALTH AND DEVELOPMENT TEAM:

- Our community workers contacted 194 community members and encouraged and motivated them to apply for the widow and senior citizen pension by using the services of BBMP and other relevant agencies.
- The CHD team identified 53 school dropouts and motivated them to enroll back to school.
- 14 Community women from Jeevanahalli community, who work as housemaids, saved monthly Rs.9700/- for 12 months. In March 2022, Rs. 120400/- was distributed among them.
- A Cancer screening camp was conducted in February 2022 in Janakiram layout and 60 community members attended the camp. The camp was organized by Indian Cancer Society team in collaboration with CUF to detect sickness in the early stages to save lives.
- Women's Day celebration was organized in Ulsoor and Janikiram layout. 70 women in Ulsoor and 68 women in Janikiram layout enthusiastically participated in competitions like mehandhi, rangoli, nutritious food display and group games.
Mrs. Thabbasum and Mrs. Anitha from Vimochana gave a speech on Women's empowerment. Mrs. Gnana Chitra Executive director, CUF gave a speech on women's day.
- Geriatric training was conducted by Nightingale Medical Trust for 26 female primary care givers in the Ulsoor community.
- In March 2022, Concerns distributed slippers donated by Greensole to 1102 children across 8 government and private school in Bangalore. Greensole refurbish discarded sports shoes into comfortable footwear and also provide these to the needy, protecting them from diseases caused by unprotected feet! During the distribution we were encouraged by the visit of Mr Ramesh Dhama Bohara, Co-Founder of Greensole who came to distribute the slippers.

Rehana wife of Sheik Jalal, Sheik Jalal is 45yrs old and lives in Janakiram layout. He was an alcoholic and was sick for 1 year. 7 months ago he advised to do a test and it was confirmed that he has throat cancer. However, he never went to the hospital for treatment. Through Concerns CHD team's motivation he came to the ICS cancer screening camp and now he started treatment.

The hospital has said that he is in the last stage of Cancer now. His wife Rehana is also a heart patient and has high BP. They live in a single room with no proper facilities. They have a son who works in a garage and helps the family. It is difficult for them as they manage without support so with the help of a donor Concerns was able to provide the family dry ration.
