CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTRES

PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES IN THE CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTRES:

- Children had settled down with settling plan, so teachers started following the curriculum using Teachers handbook.
- PIL India Pvt. Ltd. Supported the Concerns Child Development Program in Preparing young children through an enhanced learning process for formal education. Through their support we procured few Furniture & Fixtures, helped to keep up infrastructure/ Up-keep Roof fixture and to buy Learning Material from Key Education also some library books for 165 children of age below 6.
- CLAP registration process for all the children got completed with assistance of Ms Gauri of Key Foundation Education.
- Child Protection Policy Committee meeting held on 1st August 2024 was conducted and it was decided that details of the children as mentioned on their Aadhaar card must be submitted, details of adults pick up need to provided and information about children health issues any learning disability or physical & intellectual disability so the teachers to handle children according to their needs.
- 14th August Wednesday teachers meeting held to teach about chart presentations for Parent workshop.(staff training Pc)
- Children celebrated Independence day by participating in the activities like India flag badge making, choreography for patriotic songs , learning national anthem, dressed up like National leaders and participated in march past and flag hoisting.
- On 6th September health assessments for children was done done assisted by ECCE students.

COMMUNITY INITIATIVES

PROGRAM AND ACTIVITIES OF THE COMMUNITY INITIATIVES TEAM

- **BACK TO SCHOOL PROGRAM:** Identified 30 school dropouts, motivated them to join the school. successful in helping 10 children rejoin school.
- 22 Life coping sessions were conducted in 7 different Schools and in the community center for 718 students. The Life coping session were conducted.
- **TEEN'S WORKSHOP I:** "Yours truly theatre" team conducted a session on 31st July 2024. 46 students participated in the program: Theatre workshop was conducted to explore creation through creativity, to help participants to overcome mental and creative boundaries, handle different situation and focused on 'FUN with art' through experiential learning.
- **TEEN'S WORKSHOP II:** on 4th July 2024, Menstrual hygiene session for Jyothi Kannada Primary school students was conducted by Krithu Jayanthi College intern students and organized by Mrs Yeshodha. 72 girl benefited from the session.
- **TEEN'S WORKSHOP III:** Child right session for teens club children: Child right session was conducted on 27th August 2024, by Human right MANASA SICHREM for the Teens in Jyothi school. 119 Children participated.
- **MEDICAL CAMP I:** on 3rd August 2024 Cancer screening camp was conducted in Baiyapanahalli community members to ensure healthy lives and promote well-being for all at all ages. The Camp was organized by Indian Cancer Society (ICS) in collaboration with Concerns Universe Foundation. 80 community men and women participated in the camp. The follow up was done for 3 women, One of the women had a breast tumor, she underwent surgery and is doing much better.
- **Well baby show:** A program conducted on 6th and 11th October for young mothers with infant from 6 months to 18 months. 28 young mothers participated in the program with their children. Visit was made to 48 houses for baby show and monitoring the assessment were made in Janakiram Layout and Jeevanahalli community to follow up on mother and child on diet, hygiene and child & child rearing practice.
- 642 community members were assisted in application and correction in government cards/ proof in order to avail the government benefits.
- **Bank Account opening session:** The session was conducted on 28th August 2024 by UBI Bank Manager Mr. Eashwar and Assistant Manager Mr. Raju from Banaswadi branch, 24 community women benefited from the session.
- **Human Rights session** was conducted by MANASA SICHREM, high court and civil court lawyer and the team were present. The session was conducted on 23rd August 2024 at Jeevanahalli Community where 24 community members were present and on 18th September 2024 at Ulsoor Community where 32 community members were present.
- 6 chronic ill patients were referred for free treatment and supported to admin in a residential HOME.
- 2 community women from Ulsoor and Janakiram layout were referred to
- Human rights for support family issues and domestic violence 13 community members.
- 3 transgenders were referred for skill training and job placement
- **Support for women and child in distress:** A woman deaf and mute who had domestic violence and crisis by their family members, was taken to the psychiatrist and referred to other service provider for counseling, residential home and support.

PROGRAM AND ACTIVITIES OF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE

- Enrolment process continued to take place in July.
- A time table has been set and classes have been going on as planned.
- Few products related to the Assistant Beauty Therapist course had to be bought for the next batch.
- The college rules and regulation was oriented to the students and the discipline form was given for signature.
- Health and development, Life Coping, English/ Interpersonal skills classes are being conducted weekly one for all the students.
- Inauguration and Talents day was planned for 26th July.
- Inauguration and talents day was conducted on 26th July. All students participated in Solo dance, Group dance, Group singing Speech, Rangoli, Mehandhi, Cooking without fire, Drawing and painting. All students participated enthusiastically and encouraged one another. They all received a gift and enjoyed their snack.
- WhatsApp group was created for all the students.
- On 7th August Health check-up was done for all the Community College students. A team from Muthoot Finance conducted the check-up, blood test was done to check Blood Pressure, Blood sugar level, Cholestrol and Creatine. The results were given and follow-up was done.
- On 8th August, NSDC (National Skill Development Corporation) Exam was conducted for the previous Batch students. 14 Self-employed Tailoring students and 7 Beautician students attended the theory and practical exam and passed the exam.
- On 14th August 2024, Our Concerns Community College students celebrated Independence by singing the National Anthem and by creatively presenting The National Leader's contributions, The National Symbols, the story of what happened on Independence day, and the different Cultures of India. All the students participated and sweets were distributed to all.
- On 21st August 14 Assistant Beauty Therapist students went to a Vaibhav store which is in S.P Road, the students learnt about the different Beauty products available in the market and also purchased a few for them to practice.
- On 26th August Computer students went with the trainer to S P Road. They learnt to take quotations for different computer related products.

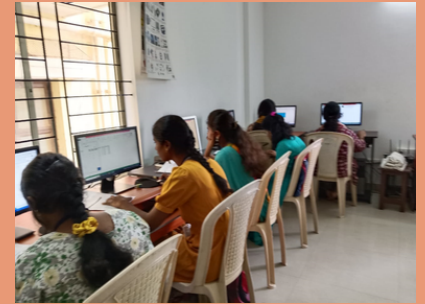
